

How to Apply to the ESL SCOPE Program (Click on *Links* to Reach Websites)

Complete information about the ESL SCOPE program is available on the [ESL NET website](#).

1. Create a [Friends of Penn State](#) account.
2. Go to **Graduate Admissions Applications** and complete the [Non-Degree Graduate Application](#).
3. Register for the first course in the ESL SCOPE series, EDUC 466: Foundations of Teaching English as a Second Language. **(See 3a or 3b below)**
 - a. **If you are registering as a non-degree student** for the next semester, you will need to wait until course registration for non-degree graduate applicants opens on **December 1st** to register for the first course, EDUC 466. **Skip to Step 4 now, and complete other information.**
 - b. **If you are applying for the Master's in Teaching and Curriculum or Master's in Literacy Education**, you only need to wait 24 hours to enroll in the first ESL course, EDUC 466. **Remember to complete Steps 4-6 below.**

To register: Log into [e-Lion](#) through [the Penn State Harrisburg](#) website using your Friends of Penn State username and password. The [e-Lion](#), [ANGEL](#), and [webmail](#) links can be found at the top right of the webpage.

4. Go to the [ESL NET](#) website. Click on the [FORMS](#) tab at the top of the page. Complete the following forms and submit these to the **ESL SCOPE office address** listed at the bottom of each form: **a) Student Information; b) Application for ESL Certification Completion; and c) Scholarship Application form**, if you are applying for the grant scholarship. (Once approved for the scholarship, you will also need to complete, sign, and submit the **Memorandum of Understanding** form.)
5. Go to the [ESL NET](#) website.

Click on the **SCOPE Program link** found on the right side of the page. Review the orientation information:

- a) Obtain a [PSU Access Account](#) and activate it;
 - b) Obtain and activate a [PSU ID](#) by going to any [PSU campus](#);
 - c) Check your computer for compatibility [Computer Recommendations](#);
 - d) Access [ANGEL](#), the course management system, for EDUC 466 orientation information and the [TaskStream](#) key and program codes; and
 - e) Create a [TaskStream](#) account, following the directions provided.
6. Email your faculty instructor for EDUC 466 with any questions or concerns.
